



JAPAN AIRLINES TAKES DELIVERY OF ITS NEW BOEING AIRCRAFT WITH THE THALES IN-FLIGHT ENTERTAINMENT SYSTEM ONBOARD

Neuilly-sur-Seine, October 25, 2010 – Thales, a leader in In-Flight Entertainment (IFE) and connectivity systems, announced that Japan Airlines has taken delivery of its first of four B767-300ER with the TopSeries In-Flight Entertainment System onboard. The aircraft seats 30 people in business class and 197 in economy. In both classes, most passengers have a 10.6' widescreen display with slim-line control unit. The system supports broadcast audio, audio and video on-demand, and ASXi moving map application powered by Airshow®. The system also provides USB and RCA ports for personal electronic device connection. USB ports enable travelers to charge personal devices during flight and RCA ports enable travelers to view their own personalized content. Expected entry into service is slated for late October. All four aircraft will deliver by January 2011.
